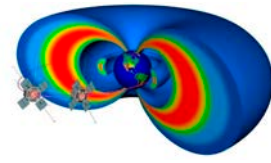




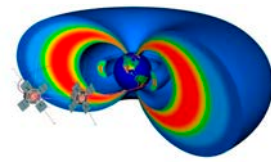

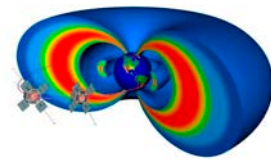
Guest check-in etc.

- Aug 23 – 4.08 a.m. Launch window opens



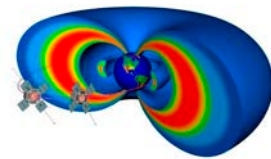
For Team members helping with E/PO and PAO activities

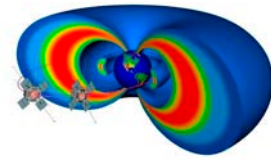

VVIP information



- The VVIP briefing and pad tour is on the 22nd. The bus arrives on Wednesday the 22nd at the Doubletree at 8:30 am and leaves at 9:00 am. It goes to the guest briefing first then the photo op at the pad. It leaves the pad at 11:45 am and brings folks back to the Doubletree. It should arrive there about 12:15PM
- The VVIP launch viewing –the Bus departs the Doubletree at 2:15 am. I would recommend being there by 1:45 am. There will be some brief remarks at the viewing site and a light continental breakfast.
